# OUR ACTIVITIES IN Eastern Africa

The AFD Group remains focused on a common priority: ensuring universal access to clean, reliable, and resilient energy for all. Its strategy in the energy sector is designed around four pillars:



## Accelerating Access to Energy Services for All

Over the past 10 years, the region has doubled its installed capacity, reaching 14 GW in 2023. Today, AFD Group is one of the most influential players in the energy sector across the region. It mobilizes its resources alongside key partners such as the World Bank, the African Development Bank, the European Investment Bank, KfW, and the European Union to expand electricity networks, connect off-grid communities, and promote clean, modern cooking solutions.

More broadly, AFD Group has joined the Mission 300 initiative, which aims to connect 300 million people to electricity in Sub-Saharan Africa by 2030, committing €1 billion in support.

### AFD Group supports:

- Universal electricity access programs connecting 230,000 households in Rwanda and 17,000 commercial consumers in Burundi to the grid.
- Grid extension initiatives in Kenya, Tanzania, Ethiopia and Uganda.



# **Energy Efficiency and Demand Management**

The best energy is energy that is not consumed. AFD Group is committed to promoting energy efficiency across all sectors—power supply, industry, transport, households, and the tertiary sector—helping to save billions of kilowatt-hours of energy.

Through the Programme for Energy Efficiency in Buildings (PEEB), the AFD Group is supporting investments exceeding €400 million in high-performance infrastructure, with a particular focus on the education, health, and industrial sectors.

### AFD Group supports:

- The PEEB Program to enhance energy efficiency in public buildings in **Djibouti**, along with additional initiatives in the education and health sectors.
- The SUNREF Program, which promotes energy efficiency among small and medium-sized enterprises across the region.



# Modern, fossil-free energy supply

Climate change is one of the greatest threats to the habitability of our planet. To safeguard the future, economies must transition away from fossil fuels. AFD Group is focusing its efforts and investments on low-carbon technologies and expanding energy grids.

## AFD Group supports:

- Construction and rehabilitation of hydropower, geothermal, wind, and solar plants.
- Development and modernization of national control centers in Tanzania, Ethiopia, and Kenya.
- Expansion and digitalization of electricity transmission lines in Kenya, Tanzania, Uganda, and Ethiopia.
- Regional interconnections (Ethiopia-Kenya, Tanzania-Zambia, Tanzania-Uganda).



# Backing support for energy transition policies, stakeholders and innovation

In addition to driving investments on energy transition, we also support both public and private sector actors to accelerate the region's shift towards sustainable energy. Our support includes long-term modeling exercises, collaboration on regulations and policies, capacity building, and fostering innovation.

## AFD Group supports:


- Updating the Generation and Transmission Power Master Plan for Kenya.
- Elaboration of the Energy Transition Plan (ETP) in Uganda in partnership with the International Energy Agency (IEA).
- Development of an operational roadmaps to improve distribution services and strengthen private sector participation in Ethiopia's energy sector.
- Implementation of vocational training programs, with gender-sensitive approaches, in **Ethiopia**.

In Eastern Africa, the **AFD Group**, a committed partner for nearly 40 years, has invested over **€2.5 billion** in energy projects in 7 countries over the past two decades.

The three priorities in the region, combining infrastructure development with policy dialogue, are:

- Expanding access to electricity and clean cooking solutions;
- Decarbonizing the power mix by promoting low-carbon technologies;
- Fostering regional integration to enhance energy cooperation and cross-border connectivity.
